

An Excerpt from the Speech of Saint Pope Paul VI on the Beatification of Saint Sharbel (Sunday, December 3rd, 1965)

His Holiness Saint Paul VI presided on December 5, 1965, over the beatification ceremony of Saint Sharbel in the Vatican at the conclusion of the Second Vatican Council.

"Great today is the joy in Heaven and on earth over the beatification of Charbel Makhlouf, monk and hermit of the Lebanese Maronite Order! Great is the joy of the East and West for this son of Lebanon, an admirable flower of sanctity, blooming on the stem of the ancient monastic traditions of the East and venerated today by the Church of Rome!

How could this joy not arise first in the hearts of the sons of St. Maroun? This is

what our venerable brother Cardinal Patriarch Paul Pierre Méouchi affirmed with such force in profound words for which we thank him deeply. For the Maronite Order and for Lebanese Catholics, this day is truly a great day. This is why it is also a pleasure for us to greet the members of the delegation that the Lebanese government has sent for this occasion, as well as those of the other delegations. We are very sensitive to this gesture, and the presence of these personalities reminds us of the warm welcome that all of Lebanon, without distinction of race or religion, once reserved for us during our stopover in Beirut. Thank you all with all of my heart."--

Saint Spotlight

Saint Teresa of Avila, Doctor of the Church

Feast Day: October 15

Saint Teresa of Avila entered the Carmelite Convent in 1535, around the age of 20. After her profession the following year, she became seriously ill. During her prolonged illness, she began the practice of mental prayer. She resolved to found a reformed Carmelite convent, correcting the laxity which she had found in the cloister of the Incarnation and others.

Saint Teresa was a prominent Spanish mystic, Carmelite nun, and writer of the Counter-Reformation. She was also a theologian of the contemplative life through mental prayer. She was a reformer of the Carmelite Order and considered to be, along with St. John of the Cross, a founder of the Discalced Carmelites. She died in the year 1582.

She was canonized in 1622, forty years after her death, by Pope Gregory XV, and then in 1970 declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Paul VI.






